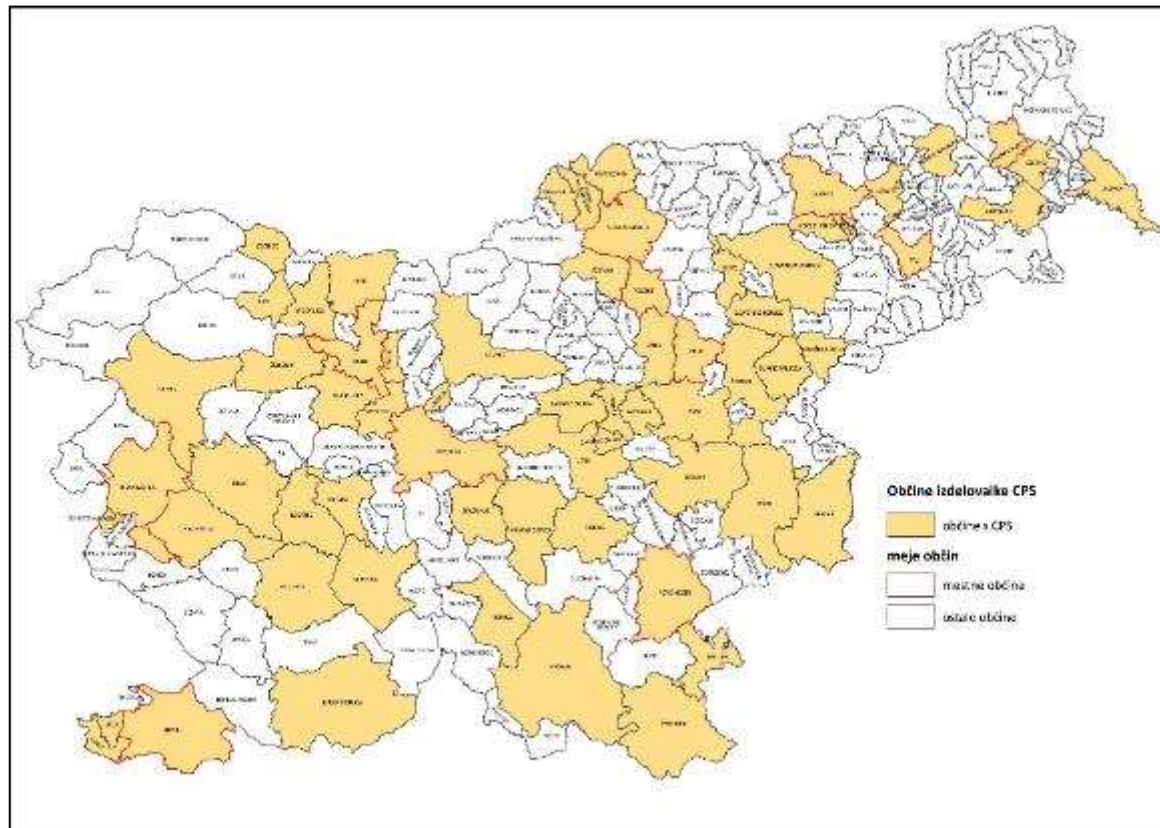

Current status on SUMP^s in Slovenia

- 77 municipalities (of 212) with SUMP^s
- Updated National SUMP Programme
- Active NTF as driver (PROSPERITY, Care4Climate)

Regulation

- Currently SUMP not legally binding or defined
- Municipalities encouraged to prepare them, funding available for development and implementation
- Challenges with quality assurance, regional cooperation, small / large municipalities, integration with spatial plans and other documents

Need for SUMP law now recognized, but approach not yet clear



PRIORITIES FOR NEXT YEARS

Activities financially supported by LIFE project CARE4CLIMATE for next 8 years

- Revision of national SUMP guidelines on local level
- Introduction of regional SUMPs (regional coordinators, pilot projects, approach development, guidelines)
- Development of SUMP quality control (content)
- Regular financial resource for SUMP measures overview
- National task force and External advisory board

Next steps

Development of thematic guidelines

- Sustainable parking policy
- Green city logistic
- Citizen engagement in SUMP development process
- Monitoring and evaluation of SUMPs and measures
- Integration of spatial and transport planning on local level
- MAAS
- Alternative PT services
- Mobility management for large road reconstructions
