WHAT is U-MOB LIFE?



WHY U-MOB LIFE?

The EU strategy on urban environment poses to change the balance among different transport systems, favouring public over private and reducing the impact of car traffic.

Universities are important poles of attraction for frequent travels generating thousands of daily trips. Also, they are a powerful instrument to implement EU policy now and in the future, as they are able to make decisions regarding, among others:

- The territorial management of campuses.
- The infrastructure and services within the campuses.
- The work/study schedules of university population.

OBJECTIVES

The specific objectives of U-MOB LIFE project are:

- Raise awareness about the need of reducing CO₂ emissions from European universities and the important role of universities regarding education of present and future generations.
- Create and consolidate a "European University Network for Sustainable Mobility" able of transferring best practices during the project and multiplying best practices in the long term after LIFE.
- Communicate attractively and disseminate the knowledge on best practices in university campuses among EU universities.
- Promote and build capacity for the professional figure of "Sustainable Mobility Manager" at European universities: define a qualification profile and develop a course to train Mobility Managers
- Define and implement best practises in European campuses in order to reduce CO₂ emissions during the project and follow reducing CO₂ emissions after LIFE.
- Foster the development of sustainable mobility policies among public authorities and transport companies.

Budget: 1.329.427€ - 60% funded by the LIFE programme.

Partnership: 6 partners from 4 European countries: Spain, Netherland, Italy, Poland 4 universities – 1 consultancy - 1 foundation

- Creation of the first U-MOB network of universities for sustainable mobility

- Implementation of sustainable mobility strategic plans at U-Mob network universities
