

- -Availability of optimal cycling equipment and electric vehicles for all groups of people, city residents, city visitors and tourists














DANOVA

MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT: to improve the accessibility of airports, ports, railway and bus stations for the blind and partially sighted by improving accessibility to services as well as access to information.

Pilot action measures were implemented according to the **Local Assessment Accessibility Report** and sorted according to the urgency of implementation:

- 2x Large freestanding indoor bus timetable display and design of graphic interface
- Larger format timetables (A3)
- Acoustic signals for traffic lights covering all the cross-roads around the main bus station

- Bus station map - a floorplan with important information on exits, platform, information and sanitary facilities


Improved delivery in pedestrian zone

DURATION: from 1.4.2023 till 30.3.2026 11 Partners from ITA, SLO, PL, HU, B, D

MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT:

To continue the decarbonization of the last mile delivery in the city centre due to expansion of pedestrian zone;

Implementing measures from adopted (Sustainable Urban Logistic Plan):

- pilot establishment of micro-consolidation centres
- best practices regarding dynamic management and reservation of loading and parking spaces – curb management



1x NEW PROPOSAL

Improving the accessibility of disabled passengers and passengers with limited mobility in the Danube region with innovative services

DURATION: estimated 2024-2027

Partners from CRO, SK, SLO, BUL, A, MNG, MLD, BIH, CZ

MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT:

Improving the physical accessibility to transport in the Danube region for all disabled people with the help of innovative services;

- providing data on network availability through the fully accessible DTIS (Digital Travel Information Services);
- creation of a smart network of transport facilities that will operate based on the interchange of practices and services in the Danube region.

TOTAL BUDGET: 2.713.790,00 EUR BUDGET MOM: 177.650,00 EUR

CO-FINANCE RATE: 80%
